Corruption & Capture

- Campaign finance = legalized bribery
- Bottom 90% of Americans ignored
- Corporate-written legislation

Widening Inequality

- New Gilded Age of extreme wealth disparity
- Al and automation threaten to deepen divides

Rigged Political System

- First-past-the-post voting suppresses voter choice
- Partisan primaries exclude independents
- Gerrymandering distorts representation

Collapse of Trust

- Record-low approval of Congress
- Millions losing faith in the democratic process



The Pro-Democracy Space

The Struggling Pro-Democracy Movement: Is It Working?



Pro-democracy orgs are working hard—but are often siloed without a unifying movement to give their reforms broader meaning or urgency.



Civic innovators build powerful new tools, but lack political allies willing to govern in new ways.



Bridging efforts, while noble, don't spark mass engagement without a compelling cause to rally behind.



Third parties and independents face major structural roadblocks that limit their reach and viability.

The result?

\$5B/year spent yet we remain disconnected, underpowered, and missing from the mainstream conversation—even while Americans are hungry for real leadership and a new path forward.




The Perception Gap

- Our divisions are exaggerated by media and don't reflect lived reality.
- Studies show: most Americans misunderstand the "other side"
- Most people are decent, struggling under same rigged system

THE UPHILL BATTLE OF RUNNING ON PRINCIPLE

Outside the Two-Party System

Ballot access laws create nearly insurmountable barriers in many states, while winner-take-all elections create the dreaded "spoiler effect" that disadvantages independents.

Inside a Major Party

Establishment incumbents are shielded by party machines, donor networks, and media bias —making primary challenges extremely difficult for principled candidates throughout the country.

THE TWO-PARTY CORPORATE DUOPOLY

Financed by Big Money

Both parties are bankrolled by corporations, lobbyists, and wealthy donors—ensuring that policies serve the powerful, not the people.

Mainstream Media Alliances

Corporate media props up the duopoly by amplifying partisan drama, silencing alternatives, and shielding the status quo from real scrutiny.

A False Choice

The system protects entrenched power while offering only the illusion of choice. Real change means choosing something outside their rigged game.

A CROSS-PARTISAN STRATEGY: PRINCIPLES OVER PARTY

Labels Aren't Principles

Being a Democrat or
Republican isn't inherently
bad — and being
Independent doesn't
guarantee integrity. What
matters is electing principled
leaders who serve everyday
Americans.

Strategic Flexibility

We reject the false choice of changing the system from the inside or outside the two-party system. Reboot candidates run in whichever lane is most strategic — major party, third party, or independent.

Learning from Real Examples

- Trump and Mamdani:
 Show it's possible to
 disrupt the system from
 within major parties.
- Sanders and King: Show that the independent path can succeed.

The Reboot America Pledge



Who Are Reboot Politicians?

Reboot Politicians are candidates and representatives who sign — and live up to — the six commitments of the pledge.



Cross-Partisan Pledge

Any candidate or representative can sign, becoming Reboot Democrats, Reboot Republicans, or Reboot Independents.



Baseline for Integrity

Establishes a baseline of principled leadership that transcends ideology and is centered on the democratic process.



Shared Vision for Change

Provides clear standards and a shared vision for a movement of leaders who prioritize people over partisan politics.

Note: Upholding the pledge will require a meaningful accountability mechanism.

Reject Big Money
Donations

Refuse contributions from corporate PACs and special interests

3 Advance Electoral Reforms

Advocate for reforms like ranked choice voting and Open Primaries for fairer, more competitive elections.

5 Utilize Digital Democracy
Tools

Embrace innovative civic technologies that enhance participation and transparency

2 Champion Anti-Corruption

Fight to eliminate legalized bribery and conflicts of interest that corrupt our system

4 Listen to and Engage with Constituents

Maintain regular, meaningful contact with all constituents, not just donors and supporters

6 Do the Will of My
Constituents

Make legislative decisions based on constituent preferences rather than personal views

Note: You can advocate for your policy preferences—the pledge is a commitment to champion the will of your constituents.




